

Canada Soccer Club Licensing Update



In support of the updated requirements of membership that Canada Soccer has put in place for the 2023 playing season, the organization has released a public service announcement outlining the change. All Saskatchewan Soccer Member Organizations must have begun the process of meeting the standards of the Quality Soccer Provider level of Canada Soccer's National Youth Club Licensing Program ahead of the 2023 playing season.

If you have not already begun the process, the Declaration of Interest form for the 2023 Club Licensing application cycle is now available here: via <u>Submittable</u>. Member Organizations are required to hold a valid license or be working towards Quality Soccer Provider in 2023 to be eligible to receive SSA member benefits including MAP funding.

2023 Annual SSA Membership Renewal

Member Organizations are required to renew each year to be eligible for SSA Member Benefits. Members who renew on time are rewarded through Member Assistance Program Funding (MAP) and are eligible to vote at the SSA AGM. The deadline for renewal is March 15.

Regular Member Organizations (register players): \$75.00 Association Member Organizations (do not register players): \$50.00 Renewal fees increase after March 15.

PSL Season is Right Around the Corner!

Team Declaration

Declaration of Interest is due by March 1st for all competing teams for 2023 PSL.

Team Declaration is to be provided via email by authorized Member Organization contact to k.enslev@sasksoccer.com. Declared teams require team name, phone number, and email address of their Head Coach and Manager. Team Declaration communications will not be accepted directly from Clubs, Zones, or Teams.

The 2023 PSL will kick-off the week of May 15th and PSL Finals (U15 & U17) will be held July 28-30 in Saskatoon. U13 will finish coinciding with 11-Aside Provincials (July 7-9 in Regina).

NEW THIS YEAR: A minimum of one (1) U11 PSL Jamboree will be held, coinciding with U13 games in either Regina or Saskatoon. More details will be available after U13 teams are declared on March 1st.
